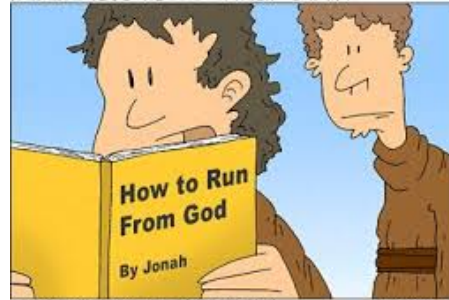

- Special giving at Easter was less than budgeted, and regular giving was a bit below budget.
- Expenditures are less than budget primarily due to Missions disbursements being only \$1,100 vs a budget of \$2,942 and Children & Youth and Young Adult Ministries spending was \$1,030 lower than budget.
- Although we we show a surplus, if we had spent all the budgeted amounts we would have had a deficit! Having said that, we are managing to
