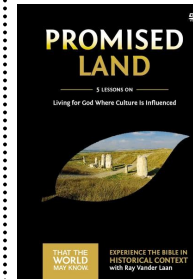

## KIDZ ZONE

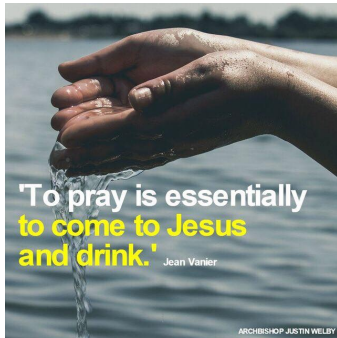
