• Gold Head = Empire (605 - 539 BC) "You, O king, the king of kings, to whom the God of heaven has given the kingdom, the power, and the might, and the glory, and into whose hand he has given, wherever they dwell, the children of man, the beasts of the field, and the birds of the heavens, making you rule over them all-you are the head of gold." (Daniel 2:37-38)

- Silver chest and arms = Empire (539 331 BC)
- Bronze middle and thighs = empire, established by Alexander the Great (331-146 BC)
- Iron & Clay = Empire.
