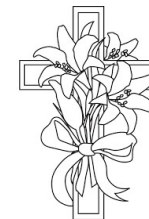

"50 Days to Your Pentecost" Devotional Challenge



Contrary to what many people think, Easter is not a single day, but a season that begins on Easter Sunday and continues for 7 weeks. This 7-week period is known as the **Great Fifty Days** or the **Week of Weeks**. During this time, the church celebrates the Lord's resurrection, His appearances to the disciples after Easter, His post-resurrection teachings, His ascension into heaven, and the disciples' eager anticipation of the coming of the Holy Spirit on Pentecost.

To guide you through this season and to help you prepare to celebrate Pentecost on June 3, you are invited to use the devotional **"50 days to your Pentecost."** This 50-day, daily devotional will challenge you to taste, see, and hear God, not just as the Creator of the Universe, but as Heavenly Father. Pray that over the next 50 days, you will receive understanding and revelation, and experience God's presence in ways that you have not known before, as you wait for His promise to be fulfilled in your life.

Contributions were \$2,440 or 6.6% less than budget revenue. However, expenditures were also less than budget by \$2,861 or 7.8%. Consequently, for Q1, there was an excess of contributions over expenditures of \$386. For 2017, we ambitiously budgeted a 5.9% increase in contributions over 2016 actuals. At this point, we are not receiving at that level. If you have any questions about this, please speak to John Telgmann. Thank you for your generous giving and faithful stewardship.
