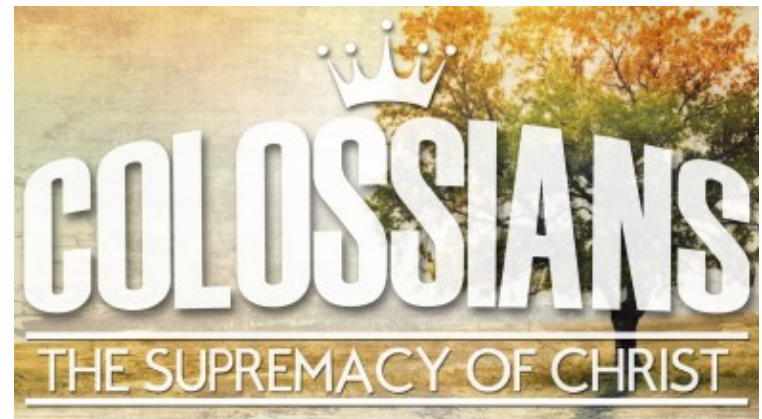

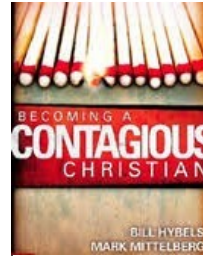

Faith Explored: Becoming A Contagious Christian

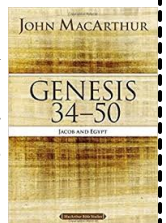

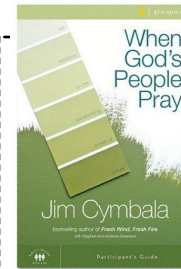
