I. The Half Truth God had the task of teaching these former slaves how to live as people and as His _____. An important part of this teaching was the handing down of the ______a set of rules and regulations—or _____outlining how they were to live in relationship with God and each other. These laws, recorded in the books of Leviticus, Numbers, and Deuteronomy, may seem odd to us, but many of them were very ______ precautions to help prevent the people from getting ______ both physically and spiritually. "I am the Lord your God, who brought you out of the land of Egypt. You shall keep all my statutes and all my ordinances, and observe them: I am the Lord." (Lev 19:36) To follow these laws was to be ritually ______ to not follow them was to be unclean or _____; and not only meant the person was outside of the Law, but was also from the community. "For the unclean they shall take some ashes of the burnt purification offering, and running water shall be added in a vessel; then a clean person shall take hyssop, dip it in the water, and sprinkle it on the tent, on all the furnishings, on the persons who were there, and on whoever touched the bone, the slain, the corpse, or the grave. The clean person shall sprinkle the unclean ones on the third day and on the seventh day, thus purifying them on the seventh day. Then they shall wash their clothes and bathe themselves in water, and at evening they shall be clean." (Numbers 19:17-19) laws like these were elaborate washing rituals prescribed to render an unclean or defiled person clean again so they could be to the community. For the Jews, keeping the Law was believed to be the best way to God, and to be in relationship with Him. "You shall therefore keep all my statutes and all my rules and do them...I am the Lord your God, who has separated you from the peoples. You shall therefore separate the clean beast from the unclean, and the unclean bird from the clean. You shall not make yourselves detestable by beast or by bird or by anything with which the ground crawls, which I have set apart for you to hold unclean. You shall be holy to me, for I the Lord am holy and have separated you from the peoples, that you should be mine." (Leviticus 20:22-26)

They used their rules and rituals to make themselves feelabout themselves and their religion, which created spiritual And eventually the people of Israel became more concerned withpurity—with keeping of the rules and rituals—than they did aboutpurity or theirwith God.		
At the time of Jesus, the Pharisees, a religious group who prided themselves on their strict to the Law, were followinglaws oral and written laws, which produced a heartless, cold, and arrogant brand of righteousness.		
The Law may have been ato holiness and godliness; however, the Jews took it to the extreme, and the regulations soon became anin themselves, instead of one of the ways to holiness. To them cleanliness wasn't next to godliness—itgodliness!
