Scripture is also clear that God is a God of mercy, grace; and
"All of us used to live that way, <u>following the passionate desires and inclinations of our sinful nature</u> . By our very nature we were subject to God's anger, just like everyone else. But <u>God is so rich in mercy</u> , and he loved us <u>so much</u> , that even though we were dead because of our sins, <u>he gave us life when he raised Christ from the dead</u> . It is only by God's grace that you have been saved!" (Eph 2:1-4)
