### The 5th Sunday of Easter ~ Sunday, April 29, 2018 "Hearing God ~ How God Speaks Part 2" John 10:1-18

"The one who enters by the gate is the <u>shepherd of the sheep</u>. The gatekeeper opens the gate for him, and the <u>sheep hear his voice</u>. He calls his own sheep by name and leads them out. When he has brought out all his own, he goes ahead of them, and <u>the sheep follow him because they know his voice</u>. They will not follow a stranger, but they will run from him because they <u>do not know the voice of strangers</u>." (John 10:2-5)

Maybe we haveideas how God will speak or not speak tous-preconceived ideas thatour hearing Him when He does speak.We can't put God in a; nor should we be too selective about the

in whatever way He desires.

### 2 WAYS GOD SPEAKS TO US

- #1. God speaks through other \_\_\_\_\_.
- God speaks to us is through His \_\_\_\_\_\_ who preach and teach His Word.

"When we preached to you, you didn't think of the words as being just our own, but

you accepted it as the very Word of God–which, of course, it was–and it changed your lives." (1 Thessalonians 2:13)

A sermon is more than just a \_\_\_\_\_ or lecture–and biblical preachers believe that God is speaking through His \_\_\_\_\_, His Spirit, and through them, as they're \_\_\_\_\_\_ to the task of preaching.

"How, then, can they call on the one <u>they have not believed in?</u> And how can they <u>believe in the one of whom they have not heard</u>? And how can they hear <u>without</u> <u>someone preaching</u> to them?" (Romans 10:14)

 Without someone
 the good news, believers and unbelievers

 alike have less chance of
 God's voice.

"Woe to me if I do not preach the gospel" (1 Corinthians 9:16)

"<u>Preach the word; be ready in season and out of season;</u> reprove, rebuke, and exhort, with complete patience and teaching." (2 Timothy 4:2)

# How has God spoken to you through preaching and teaching?

"Where there is <u>no counsel</u>, the people fall; but in the <u>multitude of counsellors</u> there is safety." (Proverbs 24:6)

God often uses the counsel of other believers to \_\_\_\_\_\_ambiguous areas or to give us the \_\_\_\_\_\_that we're truly hearing from Him.

"Every matter must be established by the testimony of <u>two or three witnesses</u>." ( 2 Corinthians 13:1)

If God has spoken something to you, He will usually \_\_\_\_\_\_\_ it through someone else because there's power in \_\_\_\_\_\_.

"Again, I tell you if two of you on earth <u>agree about anything you ask for</u>, it will be done for you by my Father in heaven. For where two or three come together in my name, there am I with them." (Matthew 18:19-20)

As members of the Body of Christ, we're \_\_\_\_\_\_to each other and to the \_\_\_\_\_\_God has placed over us. People who rarely ask for or take advice are often blinded by their own \_\_\_\_\_.

"Plans fail for lack of counsel, but with many advisors they succeed." (Proverbs 15:22)

The purpose of a "multitude of counsellors" or "many advisors" is to receive a greater \_\_\_\_\_\_\_ of godly wisdom; and to \_\_\_\_\_\_\_ that wisdom.

Sometimes it's difficult to know if we've heard from God\_\_\_\_\_ or if others have heard \_\_\_\_\_. We need \_\_\_\_\_ it-we need to ask God to confirm it.

 Take it to someone you \_\_\_\_\_; someone who is \_\_\_\_\_in their faith; whose life is an \_\_\_\_\_of godly living.

Godly counsellors are those who \_\_\_\_\_\_ what they preach and have a proven track record of making good \_\_\_\_\_\_.

Godly counsellors are able to \_\_\_\_\_God's voice and confirm what He's been speaking to you.

Godly counsellors are those who\_\_\_\_\_\_the Lord and have proven that they can be trusted because they bear spiritual\_\_\_\_\_.

Godly counsellors aren't just know-it-alls who like to tell other people what to do-they're actually \_\_\_\_\_\_\_ about what happens after they give advice because they care about you and want you to \_\_\_\_\_\_.

How has God spoken to you through the godly counsel of someone else?

**#2. God Speaks through** 

"O Lord, listen to my prayers; give me the common sense you promised." (Proverbs 119:169)

God gave us common sense wisdom as a \_\_\_\_\_\_. Common sense is the natural ability to look at things \_\_\_\_\_\_\_ frowardly; to make sound and prudent \_\_\_\_\_\_\_ based on a simple perception of the situation and facts; and to behave in a practical and \_\_\_\_\_\_ manner. Our previous experiences and \_\_\_\_\_\_ add to knowing intuitively what makes sense in a certain situation.

"<u>If any of you lacks wisdom, he should ask God</u>, who gives generously to al without finding fault, and it will be given to him." (James 1:5)

God\_\_\_\_\_to give us wisdom, and if we ask and\_\_\_\_\_He'll give it to us.

"Getting wisdom is the most important thing you can do! And with your wisdom, develop common sense and good judgement." (Proverbs 4:7)

"My child, <u>don't lose sight of common sense and discernment</u>. Hang on to them, for they will refresh your soul. They are like jewels on a necklace." (Proverbs 3:21-22)

"The words of the godly encourage many, but <u>fools are destroyed by their lack of</u> <u>common sense.</u>" (Proverbs 10:2)

Listening to the common sense wisdom that comes from God will spare us a lot of heartache and \_\_\_\_\_\_. Common sense has a remarkable capacity to \_\_\_\_\_\_ our current situation in light of our \_\_\_\_\_\_ with God and His Word; and as we hear God speaking to us, we can make godly decisions rather than bad ones.

Common sense allows us we walk in the \_\_\_\_\_\_, to tune-in to God's voice, and make decisions according to His \_\_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_.

"It seemed good to the Holy Spirit and to us..." (Acts 15:28)

The audible \_\_\_\_\_\_ of God or a word of wisdom from someone isn't needed when common sense wisdom is already telling me what to do.

### **TWO CAVEATS**

• Not everything that seems like common sense will be the\_\_\_\_\_ of God

• God can speak in ways that go \_\_\_\_\_\_ what we think is common sense. How do you use the common sense wisdom that God's given you? Did God ever speak something to you that seemed the opposite of common sense?

The Bible is the \_\_\_\_\_\_by which we judge everything else in our life. It's the standard we use to ensure that what we're hearing is in line with God's perfect \_\_\_\_\_\_. God's written word never changes–we can trust it as the final \_\_\_\_\_\_ in all things–and we need to reject anything that \_\_\_\_\_\_ the written Bible.
