# LISTENING TO, AND HEARING GOD: 4 DIFFERENT VOICES

**#1. Our** voice. Sometimes we think we're hearing from God, when it's really our own thoughts, \_\_\_\_\_, ideas, and \_\_\_\_\_ that we're hearing. These things aren't necessarily wrong; however, they originate from our and not from God. One of the ways we can quiet our own voice is by seeking to to self everyday.

"I have been crucified with Christ; and it is no longer I who live, but it is Christ who lives in me. And the life I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave himself for me." (Galatians 2:19-20)

"If any want to become my followers, let them deny themselves and take up their cross daily and follow me. For those who want to save their life will lose it, and those who lose their life for my sake will save it." (Luke 9:23-24)

As we daily seek to sacrifice a life of \_\_\_\_\_\_ for the sake of Jesus-as we daily seek to die to self-to our own needs, , and desires-we'll be better able to hear God's voice, instead of just our own.
