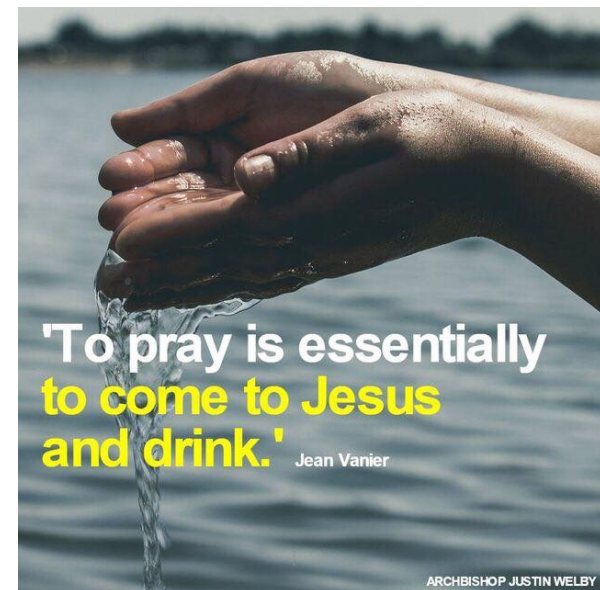
The Change For Life Campaign
