CANADIAN COUNCIL OF CHRISTIAN CHARITIES LEGAL DEFENCE FUND

The CCCC Legal Defence Fund has been set up to help protect the rights of Christian charities to exercise their faith in Canada. The Fund provides the means for the CCCC to voice concerns on issues that affect the ability of members to carry out ministry. The CCCC is intentional in intervening in court cases, preparing briefs for parliamentary committees, writing op-ed pieces in national newspapers, and academic articles for journals—all in a bid to ensure that the concerns of Christian ministries are heard.
