"And to the Angel of the church in Sardis write: These are the words of him who has the seven spirits of God and the seven stars..." (Revelation 3:1)

Jesus describes Himself here as holding 2 things.

#1. The 7 .

- □ Living churches strategize about reaching the lost. Dead churches focus on themselves.
- $\hfill\square$  Living churches evangelise. Dead churches fossilize.
