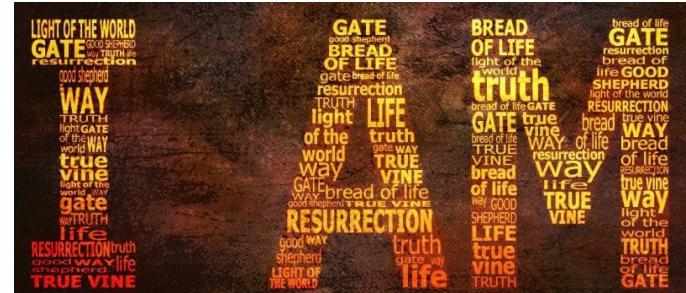

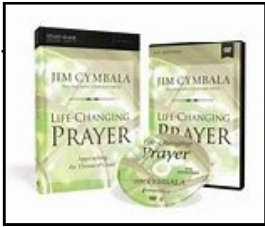


## *Living Waters Community Sharing*
