Summer Sermon Series ~ Kingdom Principles

We live in a universe that is built upon laws. Gravity, thermodynamics, cause and effect, conservation of matter—are laws that we can study and observe in our world. But what if there are other, unseen laws or principles that also govern our reality? The dictionary defines a principle as a “fundamental truth or proposition that serves as the foundation for a system of belief or behaviour.” Scripture clearly speaks of the existence of spiritual laws, and whether we acknowledge them or not, these kingdom principles have a dramatic affect on our lives and relationships.

This summer sermon series will explore eight Kingdom Principles that God has established, and if we allow them, can help us better live our lives in relation to each other, and produce the fruit that Jesus would have us produce.
