Revenues in Jan., Feb., and Mar. were averaging about \$11,000 below budget of \$13,500 per month. With no inperson worship from mid March we introduced two new methods of giving. Giving by Interac e-transfers was popular with ten mostly younger parishioners giving \$5,195 albit some giving for 2 months. There were some net increases to Pre-Authorized Giving (PAG). All together April contributions were a record \$18,695. Cumulative year to April 30 revenue at \$51,609 was \$1,337 or 2.7% higher than \$50,272 this time last year (see green matrix above on the left), but below budget by \$3,575 or 6.3% (see blue matrix on right above).

Since not meeting in person at the Senior's Centre we saved \$1,800 (i.e., 6 Sundays x \$300) in rent. Total expenditures were \$450 or 0.9% less than this time last year (i.e., 52,120), and \$3,575 or 6.5% less than budget of \$55.245.

We were a little concerned at the end of March with a \$ (5,621) deficit (higher than usual for early in the year). Thankfully April giving was way up and we reached break-even \$ (61). However, putting on the treasurer's conservative' hat I must point out that had we met in person thus paying \$1,800 of rent we would have had a year-to date deficit of almost exactly the same as at April 30 of the prior year 2019 (i.e., \$ (1,861) vs (1,848).

All in all given the current environment of health and financial stress we are doing quite well! Thank you for for your participation in the mission of Living Waters Kingston in this corner of the Lord's vineyard.
