Pray for political stability and security in Mali. This week another bloodless army coup removed the interim president, prime minister and other leaders of the transitional government. Col. Goita has regained control of the once democratic country. These coups and political crises are plunging the country further into insecurity (al Qaeda and ISIS in the north) and drawing international condemnation, suspension of assistance and the imposition of targeted sanctions.
