THE DAY OF PENTECOST & THE PROMISE OF THE HOLY SPIRIT

"I will <u>pour out my Spirit upon all people</u>. Your sons and daughters will prophesy. Your old men will dream dreams, and your young men will see visions. In those days I will pour out my Spirit even on servants-men and women alike." (Joel 2:28-29)

"If you love me, obey my commandments. And I will ask the Father, and he will give you another Advocate, who will <u>never leave you</u>. He is the <u>Holy Spirit</u>, who <u>leads into all truth</u>." (John 14:15)

• John 16:7

"Nevertheless, I tell you the truth: <u>it is to your advantage that I go away</u>, for if I do not go away, the Helper will not come to you. But if I go, <u>I will send him to you</u>."

SHORT-CIRCUITING THE HOLY SPIRIT'S POWER

3 PASSAGES ABOUT THE PERSON & WORK OF THE HOLY SPIRIT

• John 14:16-17

"And I will <u>ask the Father</u>, and <u>he will give you another Helper</u>, to be with you forever, even the <u>Spirit of truth</u>, whom the <u>world cannot receive</u>, because it neither sees him nor knows him. <u>You know him</u>, for <u>he dwells with you and will be in</u> you."

• We can grieve the Holy Spirit.

"And <u>do not grieve the Holy Spirit of God</u>, by whom you were sealed for the day of redemption. Let all bitterness and wrath and anger and clamour and slander be put away from you, along with all malice." (Ephesians 4:30-31)

• We can quench the Holy Spirit. "Do not quench the Spirit." (1 Thessalonians 5:19)

• John 14:26

"But the <u>Helper</u>, the Holy Spirit, whom the <u>Father will send in my name</u>, he will teach you all things and bring to your remembrance all that I have said to you."

6 WAYS TO KEEP IN STEP WITH THE SPIRIT

"If we live by the Spirit, let us also keep in step with the Spirit." (Galatians 5:25)

#1. Be filled with the Holy Spirit.

"And do not get drunk with wine, for that is debauchery, but be filled with the Spirit." (Ephesians 5:18)

Are you feeling empty? Could you use a top up of God's spirit?

#2. Be purified by the Holy Spirit.

"Or do you not know that <u>your body is the temple of the Holy Spirit</u> who is in you, whom you have from God, and you are not your own? For you were bought at a price; therefore <u>glorify God in your body and in your spirit</u>, which are God's." (1 Corinthians 6:19-20)

Do you see this difference in your life? Does your life bear witness to God's Spirit within you?

#3. Serve according to our spiritual gifts.

"To each is given the manifestation of the Spirit for the common good." (1 Corinthians 12:7) How would you describe the nature of your prayers?

#6. Go with the Gospel in the power of the Holy Spirit.

"You are witnesses of these things. And behold, <u>I am sending the promise of my</u> <u>Father upon you</u>. But stay in the city <u>until you are clothed with power</u> from on high." (Luke 24:48-49)

In whose power do you proclaim the Gospel–your own or God's? $\stackrel{\circ}{\Upsilon}$

What are your spiritual gifts? More importantly, are you using them?

#4. Nurture the Fruit of the Spirit.

"But the <u>fruit of the Spirit is</u> love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, self-control." (Galatians 5:22-23)

Do I want it? Am I willing to let the Holy Spirt reign in my heart, in my life, and in this church? Am I keeping in-step with the Spirit?

Is the Fruit of the Spirit ripening or rotting in your life?

#5. Pray in the Spirit.

"<u>Praying at all times in the Spirit</u>, with all prayer and supplication. To that end keep alert with all perseverance, making supplication for all the saints." (Ephesians 6:18)
