"Those who are ashamed of me and of my words, of them the Son of Man will be ashamed when he comes in his glory and the glory of the Father and of the holy angels." (Luke 9:26)

"If the world hates you, <u>remember that it hated me first</u>. The world would love you as one of its own if you belonged to it, but you are no longer part of the world. I chose you to come out of the world, so it hates you. Do you remember what I told you? 'A slave is not greater than the master.' <u>Since</u> <u>they persecuted me, naturally they will persecute you</u>..." (John 15:18-20)

#### 5 WAYS THAT GOD BLESSES US IN THE MIDST OF SUFFERING & PERSECUTION
