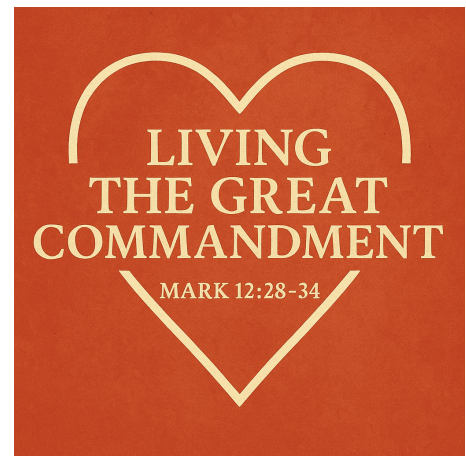

We value the earliest teachings of the Church consistent with Scripture, as expressed in the historic creeds. We also value the Protestant Reformation of the Church, when the Reformers sought to recover the clarity of the Gospel. As Anglicans, our lives are shaped by the Bible, the sacraments of Baptism and the Lord's Supper, and the tradition of Common Prayer. In our worship life, we seek to embrace the best of the historic teaching and traditions of the Church while welcoming fresh expressions of the Holy Spirit in our midst.
