"Create in Me a Clean Heart" Book Study
Experience God's Love, Personal Renewal, and Ultimate Joy

Psalm 51 is not a typical psalm of the Bible. It is the cry of someone who has been found out—and who finally stops defending himself. Then, knowing God's great steadfast love and mercy, King David experiences God's love, personal renewal, and ultimate joy.

For centuries, the Church has returned to this psalm during Lent because it tells the truth we would rather avoid: repentance is not about trying harder or offering more. It is about standing unprotected before God and trusting His mercy to reach what is real.

In *Create in Me a Clean Heart*, Anglican priest and pastor David Roseberry offers a slow, prayerful walk through Psalm 51. Its not about self-improvement, but a companion for those who are ready to tell the truth before God and discover the birthright of faith: love, renewal, and joy.

Participants are invited to read a brief section each day during the week and then gather on Sunday mornings at **9:00 AM beginning next Sunday, February 22**, to discuss what they've been learning.



"Remember you are dust, and to dust you shall return"

Ash Wednesday marks the beginning of the Lenten season—a season that begins with dust and ashes—an ancient tradition, symbolizing our humility before God. The Ash Wednesday liturgy calls us to see ourselves as we truly are; to reflect on our attitudes, actions, and priorities; and to return to God through penitence and prayer. Ash Wednesday is the beginning of a 40 day journey—a journey from repentance to restoration, from darkness to light, from fear to love, from mourning to celebration, and from ashes to joy.
