Church Vitalization Canada Pilot Project

Living Waters has been invited by the Diocese to participate in a pilot project in partnership with Church Vitalization Canada.

Church Vitalization Canada works with churches to help them find fresh vision, renew momentum, and unlock the next level of their God-given potential.

John Albiston will be visiting Living Waters for a Discovery Weekend **June 3-7**. The Discovery Weekend brings in a fresh set of eyes to help churches see what is holding them back, uncover hidden opportunities, and chart a path to the next season of growth. It will help clarify vision and align the leadership team, without burning them out or losing what is already working.

During the weekend, John will meet with Parish Council, key leaders, and a cross-section of the congregation to identify what is working well at LW and where hidden drag or underutilized strengths are slowing momentum.

The cost for this program is normally \$8000, but we are getting it for free since it is a pilot project designed to see if this process is appropriate for parishes in our Diocese.
